SCHOOL UNIFORM

Girls are ambassadors for the School and their uniform should be correct and smart at all times.

All uniform and other property, including watches, fountain pens, etc., must be clearly marked with National Weaving name tapes or engraved. Indelible clothing marker pen is also acceptable on shoes/trainers

Winter Uniform *(Suggested numbers in brackets)*

- Navy blue skirt (2)
- Navy v-neck pullover with long sleeves (2)
- White shirt (4)
- School tie (L5/U5 have special senior tie option)
- Blazer - The school blazer is the principal top garment, which must be worn to and from school for U3-U4 and every day in Assembly/Chapel for U3-U5 and on other formal occasions throughout the year.
- Scarf - A scarf, if worn, must be the regulation navy blue fleece lined college scarf
- Navy tights (6 pairs)
- St. Catherine's Rucksack
- Strong black walking shoes, loafer style or lace-up, preferably leather (not suede, patent leather, high-heeled or wedge). These are **not** available from the School Shop. Ballet pumps are not acceptable. **Please see attached photograph for preferred styles.**
- In cold weather, girls may wear a smart plain navy coat on top of their blazer, a plain navy blue fleece or a navy blue anorak.

Summer Uniform *(Suggested numbers in brackets)*

The wearing of summer uniform is optional from the beginning of the summer term and compulsory, except for U5, after half term in the summer term.

- Short sleeved summer shirt (2/3)

The summer shirt should be worn with the winter skirt. Girls may wear navy blue tights or white **ankle** socks (with or without turnover cuff) and black walking shoes. Please note, however, that trainer socks are not acceptable.

Hair

Hair must be worn off the face. Exaggerated styles, and colours are not permitted. Hair bands/clips must be black or navy and should be discreet. (Navy hairbands/clips can be bought at the School Shop)

Jewellery

The only jewellery allowed with school uniform is a watch, a plain cross and chain, plain stud earrings or sleepers (one per ear lobe only) and any Medicare item. We recommend that any initial or additional piercing, with parental permission, should only be done at the start of any

long holiday periods so that proper healing can take place before the start of term, as **only one earring will be permitted in each ear lobe.**

Sixth Form

Sixth Form do not wear uniform, but are expected to observe a respectable dress code as set down in the Sixth Form Handbook.

Sixth Form girls should have access to a smart two-piece or three-piece suit, (jacket and skirt/trousers) in a plain dark colour. This will be worn on all formal occasions, including the first day of term and Long Parliament at the end of term and on other occasions as stated in the Sixth Form Handbook. Girls taking part in musical performances must wear their suit skirt/trousers and a white shirt.

Games Kit (Suggested numbers in brackets)

To prevent borrowing of clothes and subsequent loss of P.E. kit, all kit should be clearly marked (please see enclosed letter) to include socks, shoes, tennis racquets and lacrosse sticks

- Swimming bag
- Swimming goggles – not available at shop
- Swimming towel – not available at shop
- Lacrosse boots i.e. football boots – not available at shop
- Tennis racquet – not available at shop
- House games socks – not available yet
- White ankle socks (3) not available yet
- Plastic lacrosse stick (letter and order form in previous package) - **Not required for new L5 (14+ year group)**
- 2 pairs of trainers (1 to be kept for dedicated indoor use of non marking variety)
- Mouthguard - preferably fitted by a dentist – (**O-pro visit Friday 9th September and during Lacrosse Camp on Friday 26th August and Thursday 1st September**)

Optional items

- Navy waterproof tracksuit bottoms
- Navy waterproof top (with fleece lining)

Non-uniform compulsory requirements for Boarders
