St. Catherine's School Uniform List for Senior School Academic year 2023-24

Girls are ambassadors for the school and their uniform should be correct and smart at all times.

Throughout the uniform list there are no recommended numbers for each item. Parents are free to purchase the number to suit their own laundry/boarding arrangements. Do remember that the PTAs run a second-hand shop where many of these items may also be purchased.

All items are available from the School shop unless marked with an asterisk*.

Please note that washing instructions for some of the kit and uniform needs to be followed carefully as the use of fabric softeners/tumble driers adversely affects the waterproofing.

Labelling

All items must be named. For ease of returning lost property, it would aid us greatly if clothing is named in the following way:

- name tags should be purchased with font in the same colour as your daughter's house. These labels can be ordered through the School Shop and should be ½ inch in size.
- all other items brought into school, including iPads, phones, watches etc. should be clearly labelled or engraved where appropriate.
- if possible, include at the end of the label your daughter's house, i.e. AS, ME, MI, MU, RB or ST.

You may **also** wish to write your daughter's name on the inside of the garment itself using a permanent marker just in case the name label should become detached from the garment.

Hair must be worn off the face. Navy hairbands/clips can be purchased at the school shop. Exaggerated styles and colours are not allowed.

Jewellery allowed with school uniform is a watch, a plain cross and chain, plain stud earrings and any Medicare item. We recommend that any initial or additional piercing, with parental permission, should only be done at the start of the summer holiday so that proper healing can take place before the start of term.

Please note **smart watches and fitbits are not allowed** to be used in school as they are a distraction and may interrupt learning.

Please be advised that prices of uniform are reviewed and revised each year in April and operational from Half Term in May. We also reserve the right to adjust the prices at times through the school year in case of cost increase.

Sixth Form

Sixth Form girls do not wear uniform but are expected to observe a respectable dress code as set down in the Sixth Form Handbook.

Sixth Form girls should have access to a smart two-piece or three-piece suit, (jacket and matching skirt/trousers) in a plain dark colour. This will be worn on all formal occasions, including the first day of term and Long Parliament at the end of term and on other occasions as stated in the Sixth Form Handbook. They will also need a pair of sensible, dark-coloured court or flat shoes, although colourful shoes may be worn with the suit on certain occasions. Girls taking part in musical performances must wear their suit skirt/trousers and a white shirt.

Hair must be worn off the face. Navy hairbands/clips can be purchased at the school shop. Exaggerated styles and colours are not allowed.

Jewellery allowed with school uniform is a watch, a plain cross and chain, plain stud earrings or sleepers (one per ear lobe only) and any Medicare item. We recommend that any initial or additional piercing, with parental permission, should only be done at the start of the summer holiday so that proper healing can take place before the start of term.

Boarders

The below list is compulsory but within some items there are elements of choice, e.g. casual/leisure clothes for wear during downtime in the evenings or at weekends. This is the time when boarders can express their personality and personal taste, but we ask that all clothing is in good repair, presentable and not sporting any outrageous slogans or logos etc.

If anyone is uncertain about the suitability of an item of clothing, please feel free to contact the Senior Boarding Housemistress for advice.

Laundry - Boarders' laundry is undertaken in house for them for years U3-U5 – every day except the weekends. Please provide 2 smaller mesh laundry bags to be used for light and dark underwear washing - labelled with a sew on name label. However, for ease of sorting and return, everything must be clearly labelled, either with nametapes – sewn on or stick/iron-on – or indelible marker pen on the washing label or on a stitched-in white tape. This applies to all casual/leisure clothing, coats etc., too.

In the Sixth Form, boarders do their own laundry in machines provided and again labelling is very important. This independence offers good preparation for university/college life and we encourage an eco-approach in sharing machine loads with a friend etc. Girls will be provided with laundry baskets.

School Uniform for Boarders in U3-U5 – We recommend at least 2 or 3 shirts, 2 jumpers and 2 skirts per girl so that laundry can be done appropriately and ensure that uniform is in good condition and fresh to wear.

COMPULSORY items for all boarders

A) Clothing

- Underwear and tights please supply enough for a week's wear.
- 2 pairs of pyjamas or nightdresses
- Dressing gown essential for winter months and for the occasional fire practice!
- Slippers or flip flops
- Some items of leisure wear or casual wear e.g. skirts and jeans etc., tops, hoodies/sweaters
- A smart outfit or pieces for Church on Sundays (jeans not permitted for church)
- Smart outerwear fleece or coat suitable for the season, for evening or weekend outings and for Church
- Waterproof, smart boots or robust shoes for outings beyond school in winter months, and a pair of smart summer shoes – not ballet pumps style – for summer outings or activities.

For Bronte, Symes and Keller – U3-U5 boarders – only:

- Wellies
- Gloves
- Waterproof top and bottom for outdoor weekend activities in winter months
- Hat (woolly/fleece for winter and cap/sunhat for summer)

B) Other essential items non-clothing for all boarders:

- Sponge bag containing toiletries girls say that one that unfolds and hangs on the inside of a shower door works well. A good supply of shampoo, conditioner, deodorant, a shower cap etc. is a good plan to kick-start each term. Shopping opportunities are provided at weekends and the local shops are just nearby for any essential needs, with permission to leave the site from your housemistress. Boarders can get deliveries from amazon to replenish their stock.
- 'Wheatie' style dry bed warmer, for microwave use (not a hot water bottle) to be used in line with manufacturer's instructions (available to purchase from School Shop).
- 1 duvet (duvet cover and pillowcases optional) if you wish to have these delivered to School from a mail order company, e.g. Amazon, you may. Please ensure they are clearly addressed.
- Needlework kit with mending materials and an extra supply of name tapes
- Weekend bag/cabin baggage size. For weekly boarders, this ideally is a softer fabric wheelie that can easily be stowed at the back of a wardrobe during the week.
- Rug or blanket (optional)
- Named Tupperware box for snacks stored in the common room
- Small pack away umbrella
- Power bank charger
- Charging plugs and cables suitable for your daughter devices

Shoe cleaning equipment is supplied by the School in each boarding house and is needed most by those in School uniform.

The School Shop

School uniform has to be obtained from the School Shop on site at St. Catherine's School. It is situated in the Business Centre and can be accessed via a path to the left of the Business Centre building. There are two ways of purchasing uniform from the Shop:

- **1.** <u>Pre- booked appointments</u> These are highly advisable if you need to purchase a larger number of items, or if you are not sure about the sizing of the uniform. Please send an email and we will get back to you.
- 2. <u>Remote purchase</u> we strongly advise this route if you need just a few items. Send your order requirements to <u>school.shop@stcatherines.info</u> and we will get in touch with you to discuss your order in more detail, take the payment and arrange the time for the collection. Items can always be exchanged if not worn and returned in original packaging.

School Shop is not open during Autumn, Spring and Summer half term.
